ADMISSION

COURSES OF STUDY

PRE-PRIMARY

The school provides a strong emphasis on the foundational years as it underlines the importance of appropriate care and stimulation for early years of cognitive, affective and psychomotor development through carefully guided learning activities.

We have a separate block for nursery section (M 1 AND M11) in the form of NALUKETTU. This self- contained building with an auditorium provides an extremely congenial atmosphere where the kids can hear, smell, taste and touch wonders of nature.

We are introducing a new learning scheme for KG section which gives emphasis to Phonetics as in International Schools. It is a unique phonic based approach to teaching, reading, writing and spelling to three to six year old kids

CANTEEN

School canteen facility aims to provide children of working parents to buy nutritious and healthy vegetarian food during the school day.
